CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. All Entries must be made on the Special Form and must be accompanied by the Entry Fee. **Waiver Form must be signed.**
2. No Animal is eligible for entry or exhibition unless it comes from a herd with a T.B. Quarantine and Brucellosis Free Area.
3. Production certificates must also accompany entries.
4. Official, Group or Farmer Sampling systems will be accepted.
5. All animals must be registered in the Herd Book of their respective Breeds societies.
6. All animals not of age for registration must be registered in accordance with the rules of their respective breed society.
7. The age of Dairy Cattle to be taken from 1st January in each year.
8. All livestock must be the bona fide property and in the possession of the Exhibitor at the time of entry. When reasonable grounds exist for doubt the Committee may demand a Statutory Declaration to the bona fides of any exhibit from the Exhibitor.
9. A class in which the exhibit comprises one animal shall be a single Class, a class in the exhibit comprises more than one animal shall be a Group.
10. A Heifer is defined as being under (3) years of age and not having had a calf before the date of the Show.
11. Any cow entered in a dry class, if at the time of the competition may compete as a wet cow or vice versa. Cows which are entered in the dry class which are in milk on the day of judging must be milked out immediately prior to entering the judging ring.
12. A dry cow is defined as having completed (9) months lactation or is (6) months in calf at the time of entry.
13. All bulls must have rings and be provided with leads and all females must be broken in to lead.
14. Dairy Cattle classes to be judged on Saturday at times as stated in the schedule.

15. The Point Score for the Most Successful Exhibitor is:
3 points for 1st; 2 points for 2nd; 1 point for 3rd.
2 points for Champion; 1 point for Reserve Champion
16. No animal other than on exhibit shall be displayed or exposed for sale at the Showground.
17. If in the opinion of a Veterinary Surgeon of the Society an animal on the Showground shall be injured or affected by sickness, disease, or other ailments to warrant its destruction or removal from the ground as the case may be, the Society shall be entitled to have the animal destroyed or removed from the Showground and/or shall be entitled to require the owner to forthwith remove the animal from the grounds. All cost incurred by the Society shall be for the account of the owner and shall be refunded by him to the Society.
18. To enable the necessary stalls to be prepared each Exhibitor of cattle when forwarding entries must state on the Entry Form the total number of cattle that he/she will be sending to the Show, as stalls are allocated one week prior to the Show. Exhibitors are warned that the Society cannot guarantee stalls are available if this is not adhered to.
19. No cattle can compete in any classes additional to those that are entered in on their entry form.
20. In addition all entries are subject to the General Rules and Regulations of the Society.
21. The Head Steward of each breed of cattle together with the Chief Stewards shall comprise the Disputes Committee.
22. All Exhibitors must be on the ground by 8.30am on Saturday 21st March 2009 ready for judging to commence at 9.30am.
23. In Sire's Progeny classes the Exhibitor must be the owner of (3) exhibits in the pen. The Exhibitor may not necessarily be The Breeder or Owner of the Sire. Entries shall be selected from General Classes. The name of the Sire to be stated on the Entry Form.
24. An Exhibitor may enter cattle registered in the Appendix 1,2 System for Holsteins & G.R. 1 & 2 for Jerseys. E.&O.E. (2)
