CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. If any exhibit in the opinion of the Ringmaster, Steward or Judge is not under proper and full control – the exhibit may be disqualified from competing in any or all events.
2. If a Judge considers that any exhibit does not possess sufficient merit to deserve a prize in the class in which it is presented for Judging, then the prize shall not be awarded.
3. The Judge's decision is final in all classes.
4. Any protests must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$20 and lodged with the Secretary within (30) minutes of the alleged violation of the rules.
5. Stallions and Colts **MUST** be handled and ridden by a senior i.e. a person over (17) years of age.
6. All Juniors **MUST** wear approved ASC helmets.
7. All Competitors **MUST** sign waiver forms.
8. **MAIDEN** is a horse that has not won a first prize or similar event at a recognised Show.
9. **NOVICE** IS A HORSE THAT HAS NOT WON A Championship
10. **NOTE:** Ponies (14hh and under)
Galloways (over 14hh but not exceeding 15hh)
Foal (under 12 months) Colt or Filly (3 years and under)
